

# Create a Monarch Caterpillar

**Supplies:** *Grab 1 white, 1 yellow, & 1 black and an unsharpened pencil.*

1. Line up all 3 pipe cleaners so they are even with each other, and begin wrapping them around the pencil.
2. They get wrapped around so you can always see each color, but there are no spaces between the pipe cleaners
3. When you have about 2 inches of unwrapped pipe cleaners left, you will fold the black pipe cleaner to make antennae.
4. Then wrap the white and yellow pipe cleaner around it to hold the antennae in place.
5. Slide it off the pencil
6. You have a monarch caterpillar!

# Make a Monarch Chrysalis Pin

## Monarch:

1. Grab an orange felt monarch and 1 black pipe cleaner
2. Sit down and use a black crayon to create your monarch's wing design
3. Fold the black pipe cleaner in half
4. Place the felt monarch in between the pipe cleaner to make the body of and twist the top to make the antennae
5. Ask a volunteer for a pin. Wear your monarch butterfly home or make the chrysalis (steps 6-10)

## Chrysalis:

6. Grab a green sheet of tissue paper
  7. Fold up your monarch pin so it is really small, then roll up the green tissue paper around the folded up monarch to make the chrysalis.
  8. Take a piece of clear tape to tape the chrysalis closed.
  9. Use gold glitter glue to create a line at the top of the chrysalis
- PLEASE PUT GLITTER GLUE ON CHYRSALIS ONLY,  
DO NOT PUT ON MONARCH BUTTERFLY**
10. Let glue dry and take your chrysalis home. When you open it, an adult monarch butterfly will appear!
